Dr Anthony Keeley is a specialist hip and knee surgeon trained in both traditional replacement surgery and modern techniques, such as navigated, robotic and imaging-based guided surgery.

Dr Keeley graduated from the University of Tasmania in 2000 and went on to complete his Fellowship in the NSW Orthopaedic Training Program in 2009. During post-Fellowship sub-specialist training in Brisbane, he completed two fellowships in pelvic and acetabular/hip trauma, complex peri-articular trauma, limb deformity surgery, and lower limb arthroplasty (joint replacement).

Returning to Sydney as a consultant Orthopaedic Trauma Surgeon, Dr Keeley has significant expertise in hip, knee, and trauma surgery. He joined the Orthopaedic Trauma and Reconstructive Surgery practice in 2011.

He has particular interest in primary hip and knee replacement surgery, complex revision hip and knee replacement surgery, sports knee surgery including arthroscopy, meniscal surgery, and ligament surgery

(e.g. ACL ruptures), trauma surgery and deformity correction. Dr Keeley participates in teaching activities and is involved in research activities.
