Dr Daniel Rahme is an Orthopaedic Surgeon specialising in hip and knee surgery. Dr Rahme graduated from the University of New South Wales in 1996 and then completed Orthopaedic training and gained admission to the Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons in 2007.

Dr Rahme trained in hip and knee surgery at the Sydney Orthopaedic and Joint Replacement Centre as well as centres in France, Switzerland and Germany. He is a member of the Australian Orthopaedic Association (AOA) and the Australian Society of Orthopaedic Surgeons, as affiliated and recognised by the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons for Bona Fide Orthopaedic Surgeons.

One of the first surgeons in Australia to perform total hip replacements with Anterior Minimally Invasive Hip Surgery (AMIS), Dr Rahme is now appointed reference surgeon for the technique and regularly trains other surgeons. Dr Rahme has participated in providing

surgical training and services to under-developed countries. He partakes in ongoing research projects and is actively involved in medical student, orthopaedic registrar and fellowship training.
